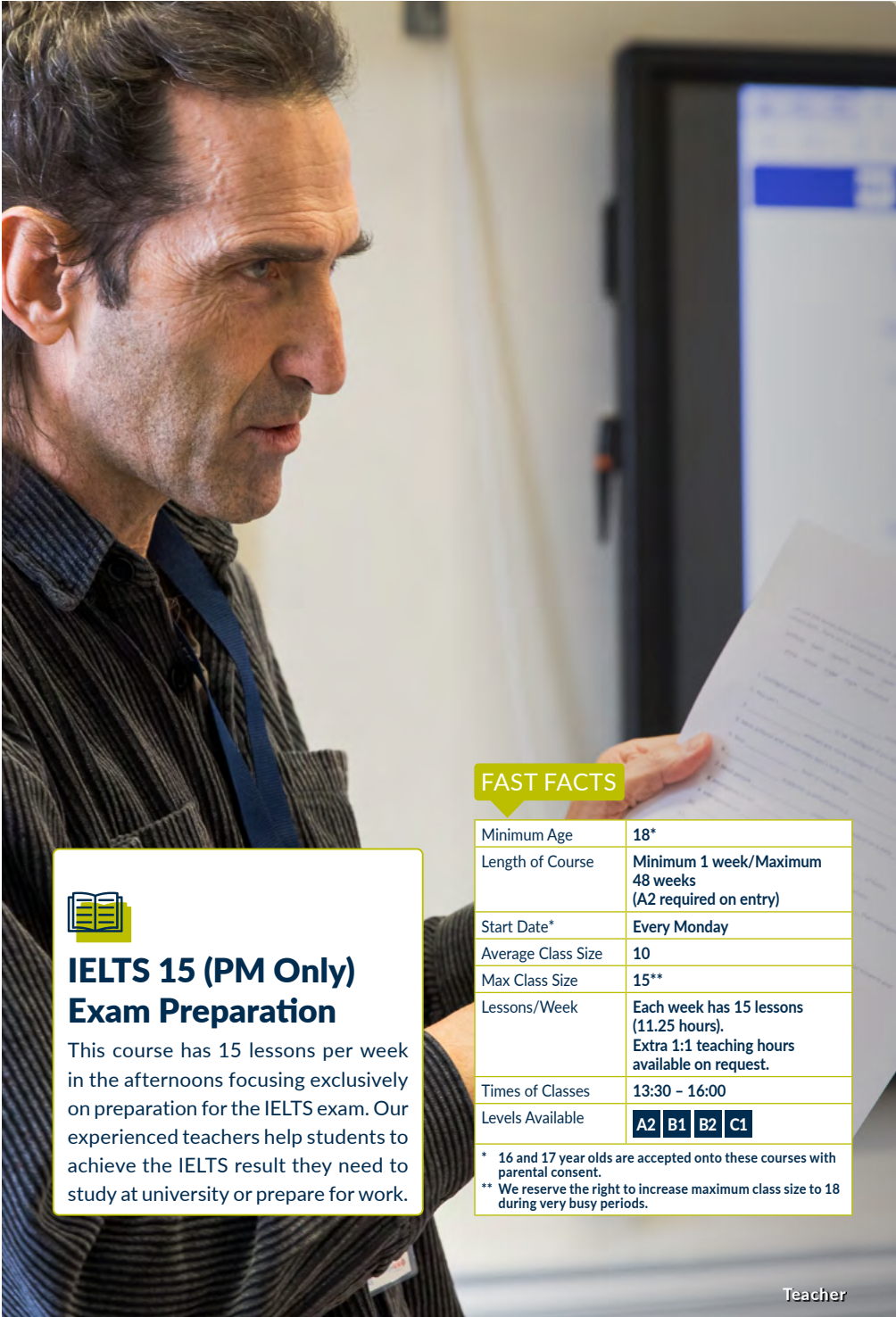

Our 50 PLUS programme is offered three times per year for more mature learners who wish to combine learning English with their interest in learning about culture. It focuses very much on fluency and developing the confidence you need to speak English for everyday situations and conversations.

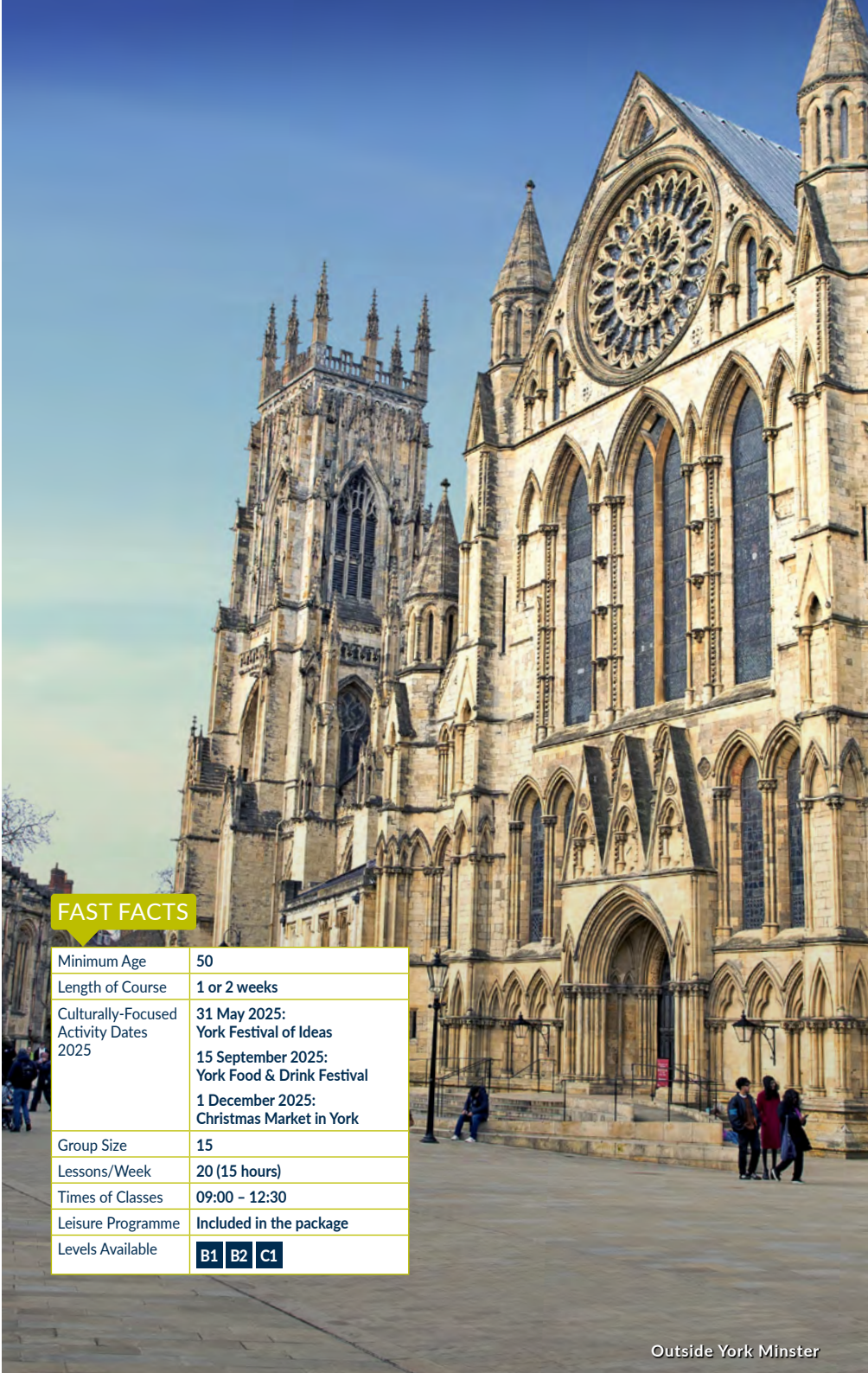
When booked on this course, you follow guided excursions to places of deep historic cultural interest, as well as participating in social and leisure activities of your choice. The course will give you the opportunity to get to know the rich culture of York and England with a focus on history, art, architecture, literature and cuisine.

As a 50 PLUS learner, you take 20 lessons per week of 45 minutes each. Lessons are held every morning, and are followed by specially organised excursions and activities where you can encounter culture and practise your English at the same time.

Professional English



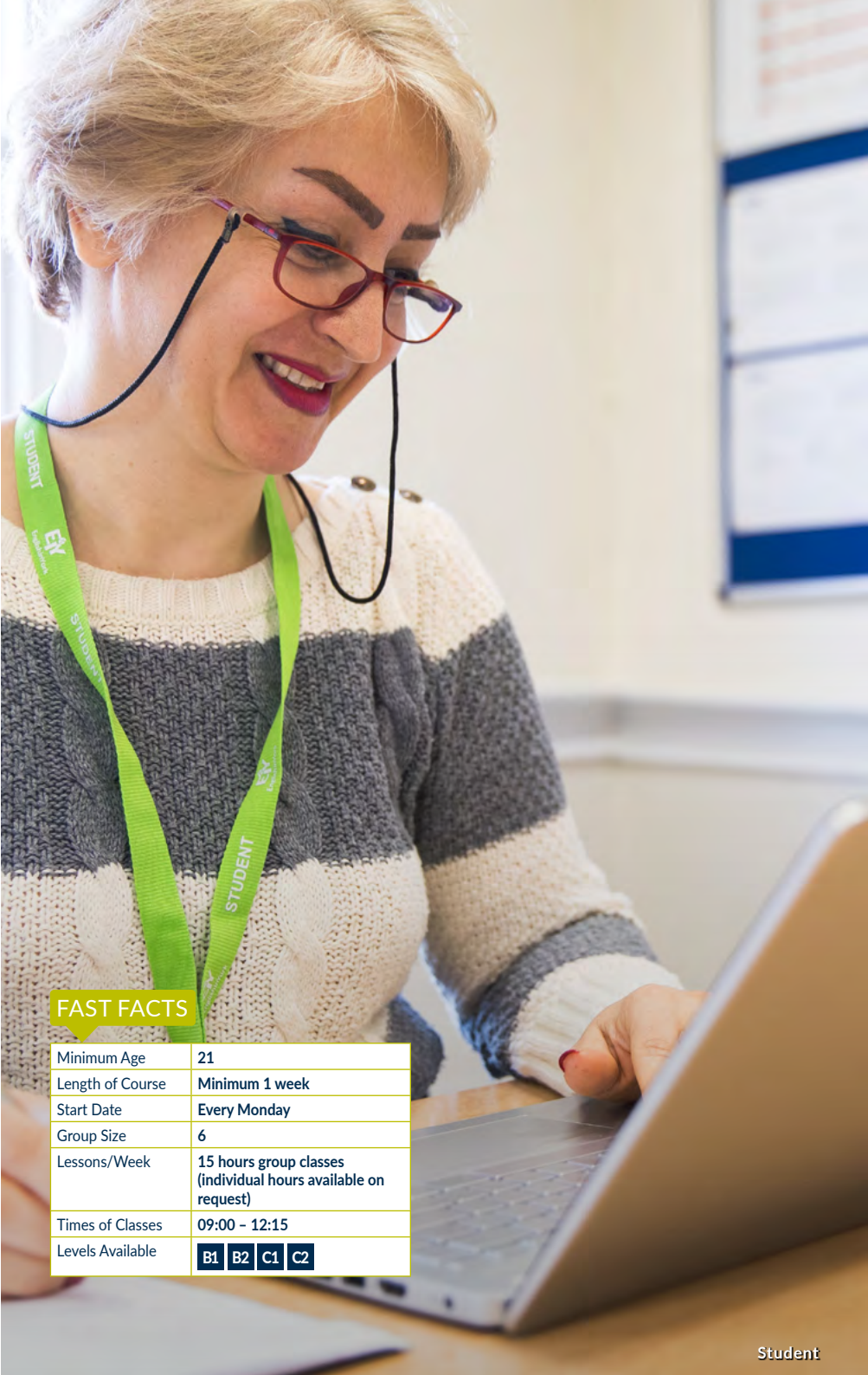
Business English Communication

Become more effective when communicating with international contacts. By following a Business Communication group course, you will develop the English you need at work: grammar and business / profession-specific vocabulary. You can also work on your professional communication skills such as leading / participating in (virtual) meetings, delivering presentations, negotiating, telephoning, socialising and writing emails. This course will also help you increase your intercultural competence (understanding ‘culture’, profiling your own and others’ culture) and give you tips to manage diversity effectively. Individual training is available if desired to create a combination course of individual and group training.

Warm Welcome

You have a choice of Standard and Executive Homestay, all of which are a short walk or bus ride from our school.

You will receive a warm welcome and a caring environment. You will have your own bedroom and a place to study. Unless you request otherwise, we work hard to ensure that there are no other speakers of your first language staying with the family.

Your homestay will offer you breakfast and evening meals every day. Lunch is available on Saturday and Sunday only. You are expected to buy your own lunch during the week. If you are going on a weekend excursion, you can politely ask your host family for a packed lunch.
