Aim 2: To explore the concepts of Togetherness, Democracy, and enlightenment in Education

and engage in discussion about their practical applications to the classroom.

Aim 3: To improve foreign language competencies in professional settings, using the discovery of

emerging ideas in 21st century education improvement as a catalyst to promote the

practice of language skills.

Aim 4: To enhance intercultural awareness by forming connections with colleagues from

different countries and sharing teaching experiences in an objective developmental

environment.

Aim 5: To develop the language proficiency skills needed in order to become more effective in

professional situations, such as giving leading/participating in meetings, negotiating,

telephoning, socialising and writing in English.

Aim 6: To develop interactive teaching methods through exposure to different ways of how to

use game-based learning and a variety of other interesting ICT tools for teaching and

learning.

1. Explicit instruction in approaches to teaching and learning in English as a Foreign

4. Observation of other EFL professionals using research and case studies with follow-up

seminar discussion to reinforce course content

5. Field research through on-site visits to Maltese schools, and lecture presentations

from Maltese high school English teaching professionals

6. Peer micro-teaching to increase course participants' awareness of the practicalities of

different teaching tools

- Be given access to the Link online learning system for two follow-up sessions in a virtual learning environment. These sessions allow course participants to meet each other and the course tutor to exchange ideas, share their teaching experiences and receive feedback on the post-course tasks
