
















Leeds Swarthmore Education Centre

Junior Super Intensive Summer Course

The Junior Super Intensive Programme is a **brand new** programme that offers junior students the possibility to have a more intensive English language tuition experience. CES International Junior Summer School combines expert English language training with a full programme of sports, activities and cultural visits.
