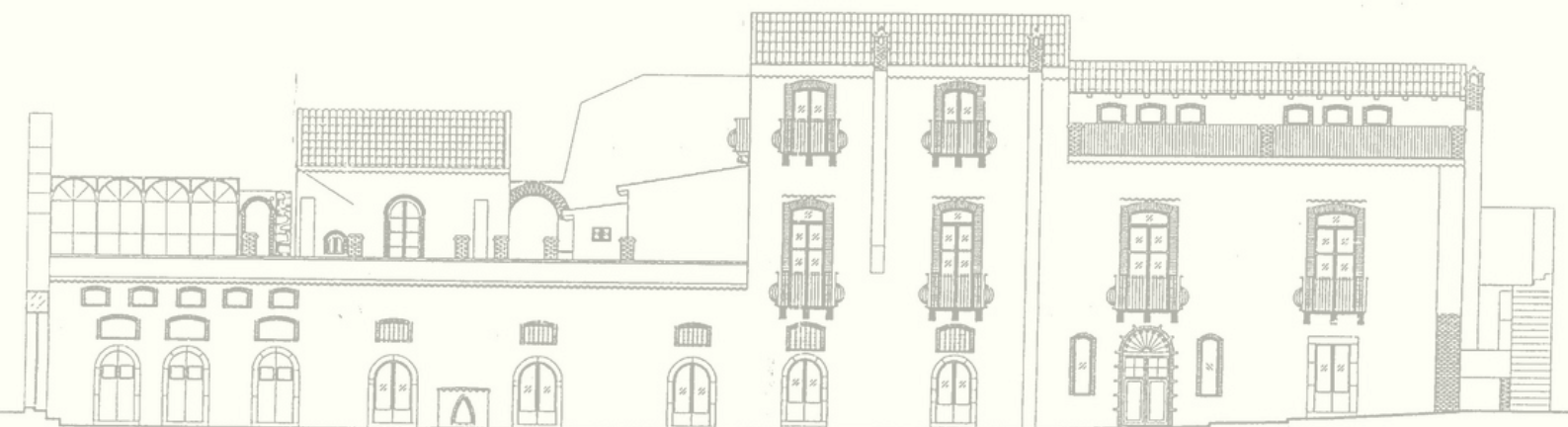
Our house

The Center for Italian Studies BABILONIA hosts book presentations by authors, a cine-forum, art exhibitions in its 2'000 square metres of botanical garden.

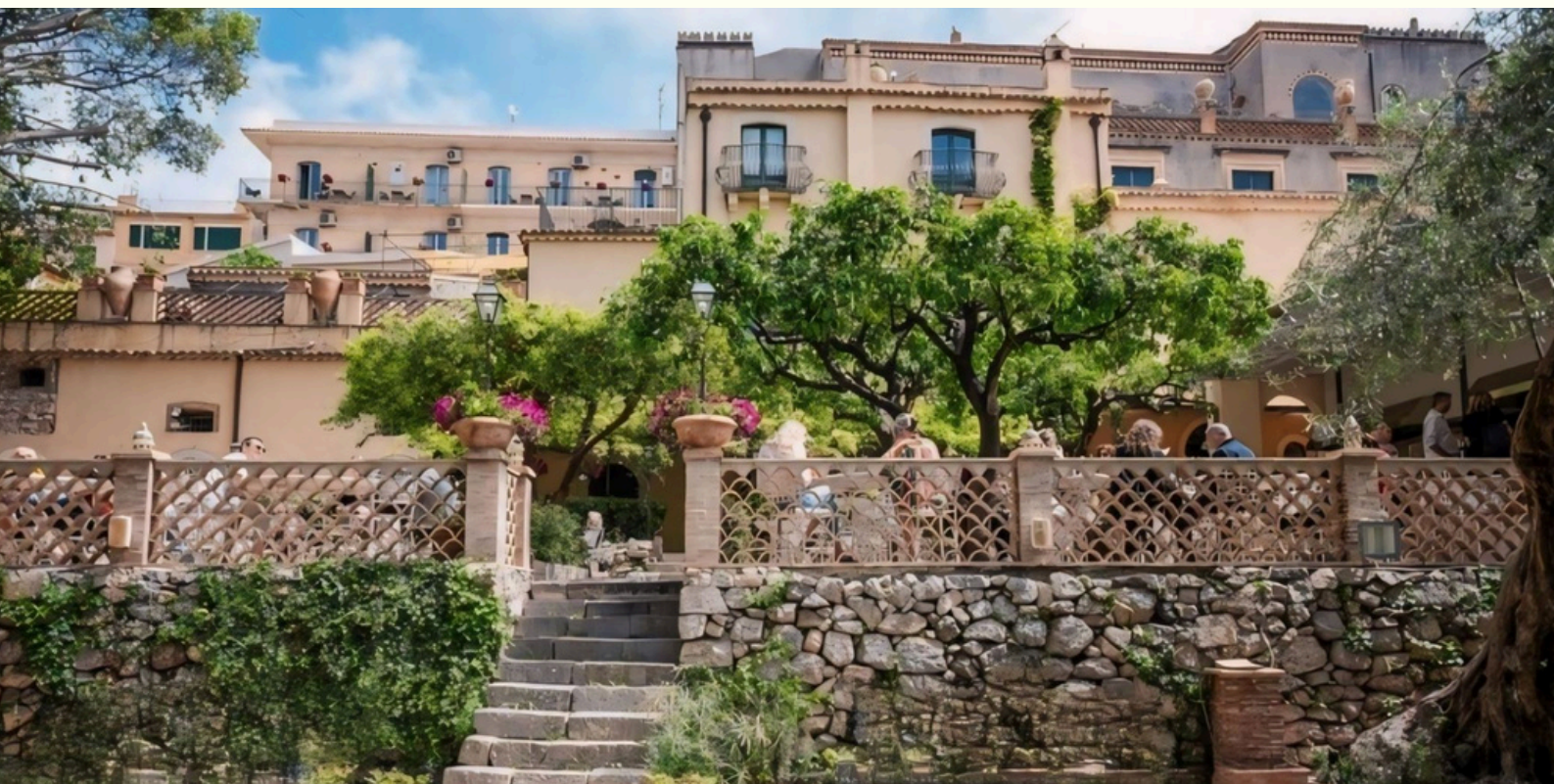
Students from around the world enrol in courses at Babilonia enhancing the academic and social enviroment. The study abroad experience is enriched by students making both local and international friends.

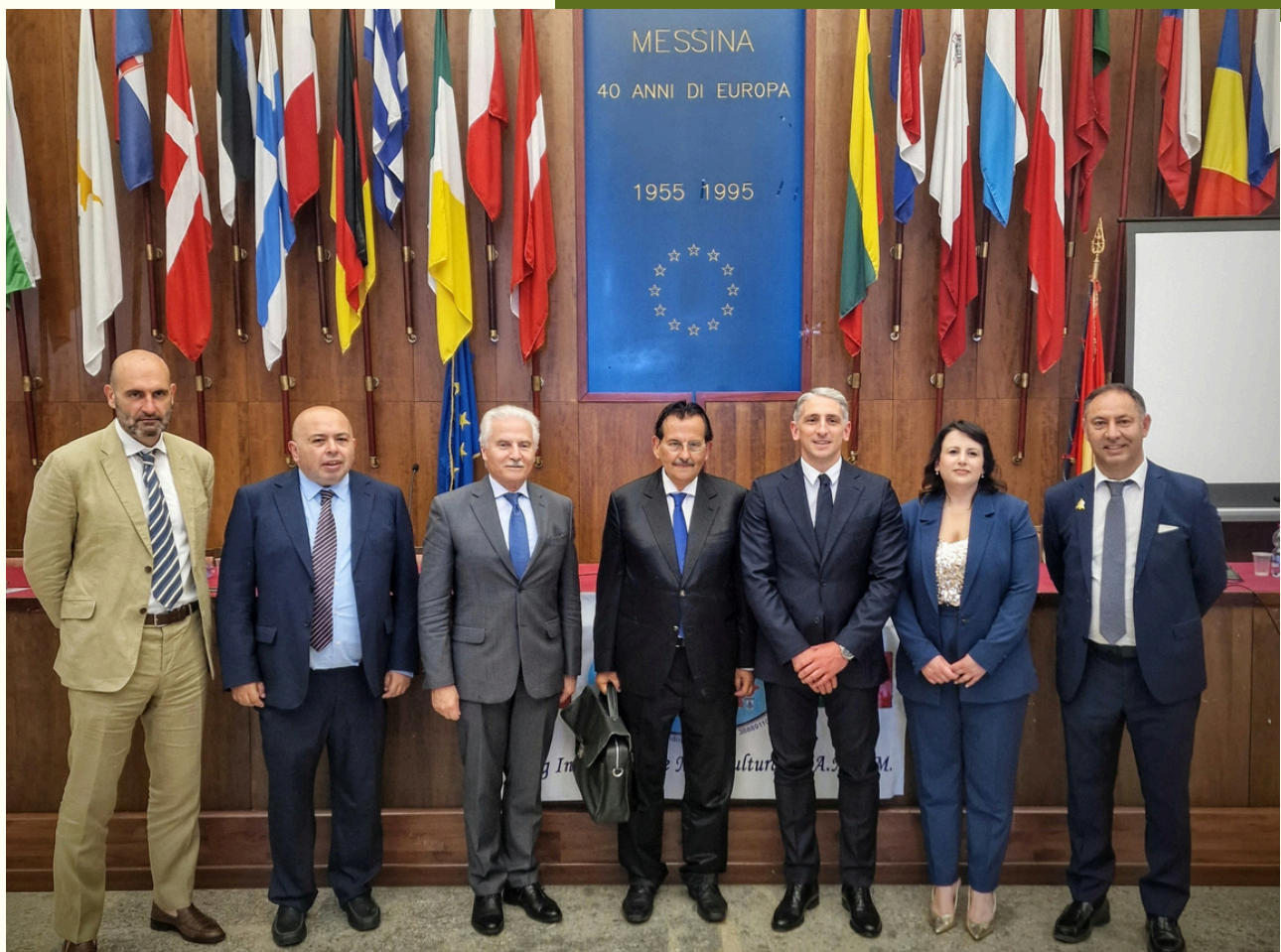

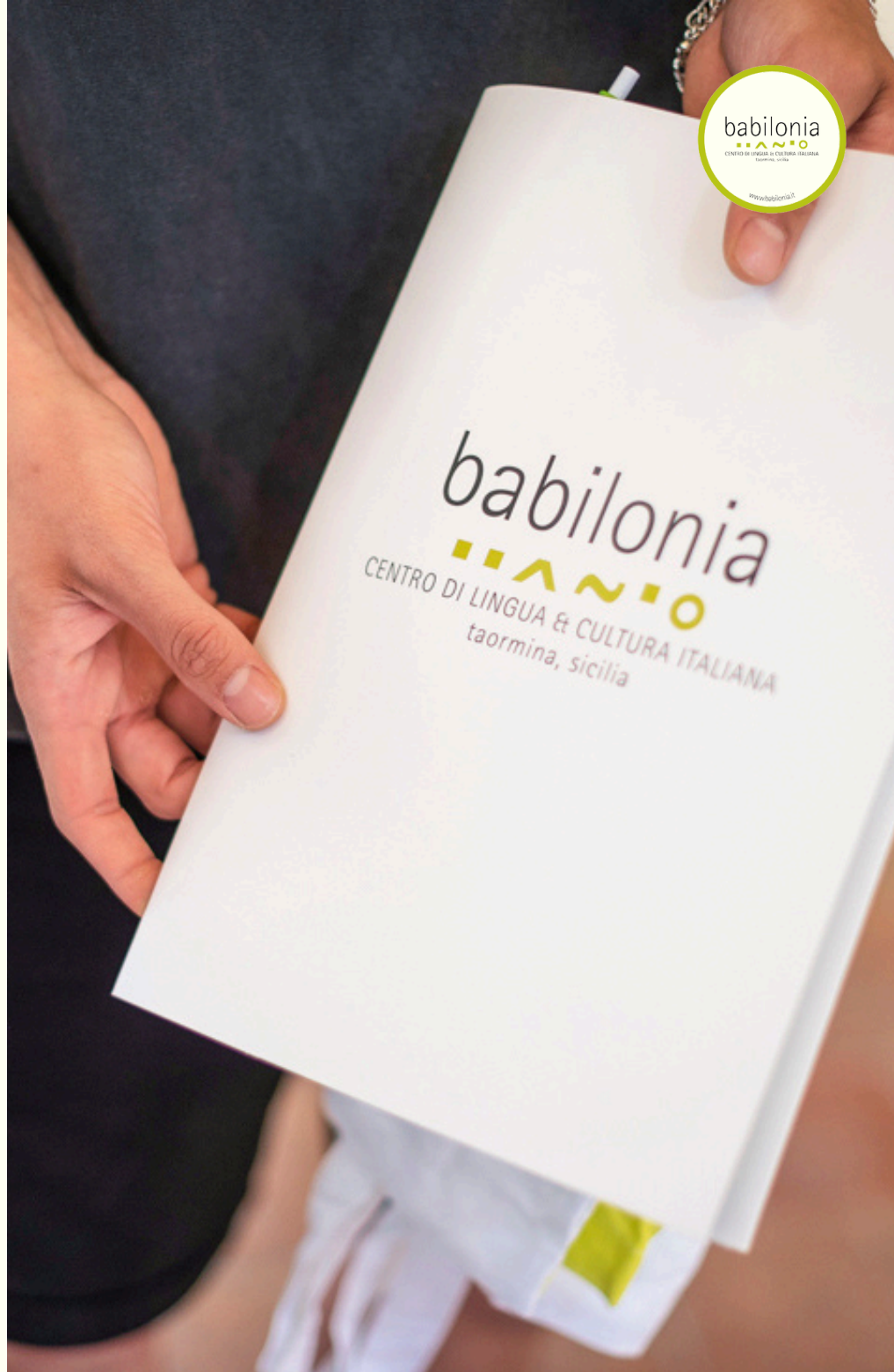

All of our teachers, as well as having a degree, have also gained certification in “Teaching Italian as a Foreign Language” at a second level (DILS II) from the University per Stranieri di Perugia which is a specific certification guaranteeing essential teaching knowledge and competences to carry out precise methodologies in an efficient way with a contextual comprehension of the profession.

The learning progress and the analysis of the students’ acquisition processes are constantly monitored by the teachers during a weekly didactic meeting in which the teachers share what has happened in the lessons, the activities and didactic exercises carried out, in order to guarantee to each student a correct development of the learning and acquisition phases, and a level suitable to his/her own linguistic ability.

The didactic material is composed of authentic texts (newspapers, magazine articles, movie dialogues, radio, cinema, TV, letters, etc.) and own material produced by the teachers of Babilonia.

The maximum number of students is 14 per class, although the average number is 4-6 students per class. This reduced number of students favors the development and active communication on the part of the students and gives each student more opportunities to shine.

During the course, there is a weekly rotation of teachers to give students the opportunity to hear different voices, rhythms and intonations, and to interact with different personalities and styles in the course of their language learning.

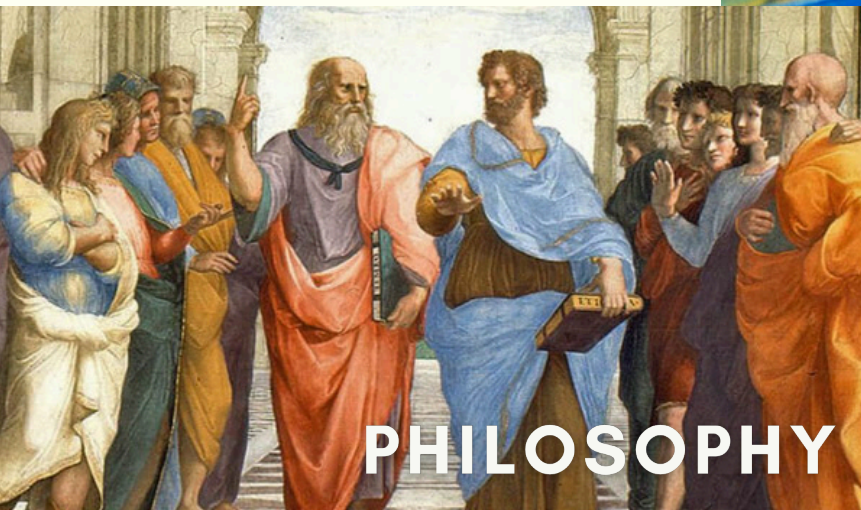

Reason for study italian pre university preparation:



This course is designed for those who wish to acquire a solid knowledge of the Italian language and prepare for the university entrance exam.

The course structure is balanced, dedicating 50% of the lessons to in-depth Italian language study and the remaining 50% to specific preparation for the university exam.

In the first part of the program, students develop essential language skills, with a focus on grammar, vocabulary, reading and listening comprehension, and expressive ability. These modules will provide students with the linguistic foundation and confidence necessary to navigate an academic setting in Italy.

The second part of the course is dedicated to preparing for the university entrance exam. This section includes practical exercises on test formats, exam simulations, and targeted sessions on response strategies. Students will have the opportunity to improve their time management skills, logical reasoning, and problem-solving for typical exam questions.

With a targeted approach and a balanced program, the course helps students achieve two fundamental goals: to gain an advanced level of Italian language proficiency and to prepare comprehensively and strategically for the university entrance exam.

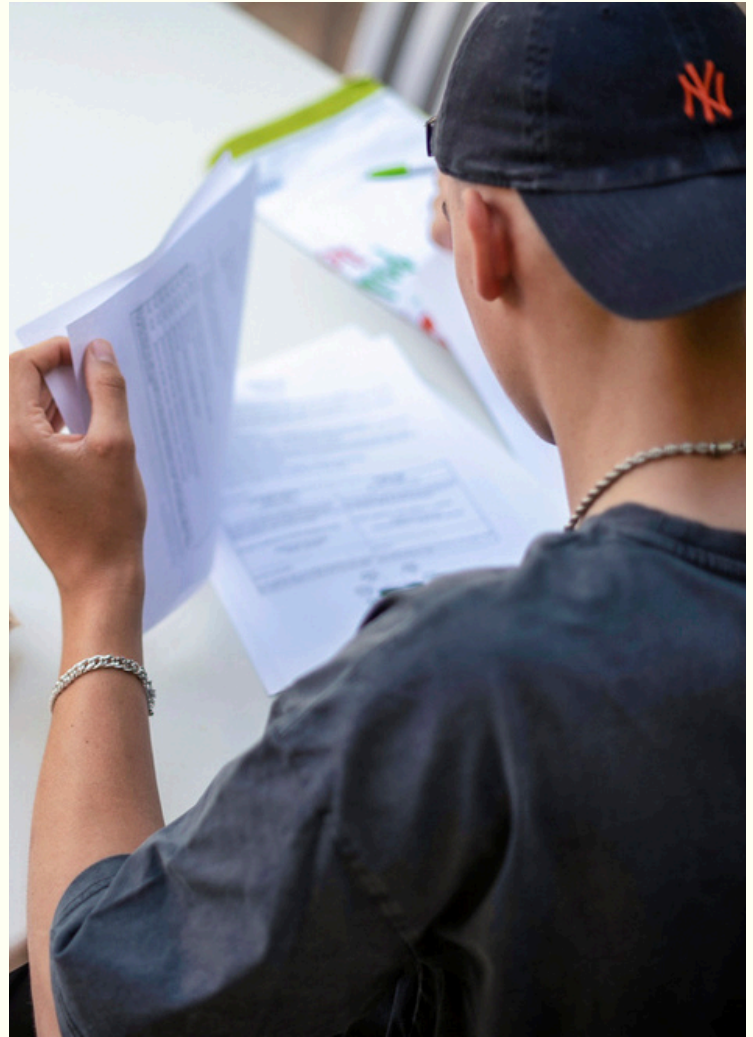

During their staying at the University they will approach the world of gastronomy on many of its different aspects, through theoretical studies, sensory analysis and first-hand experience.

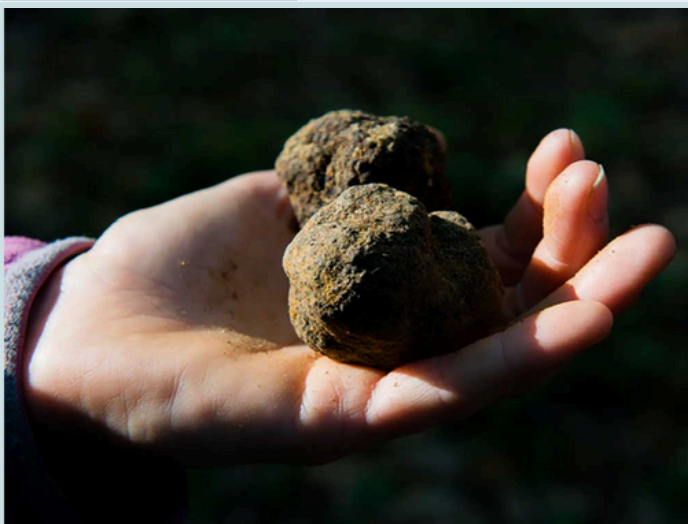

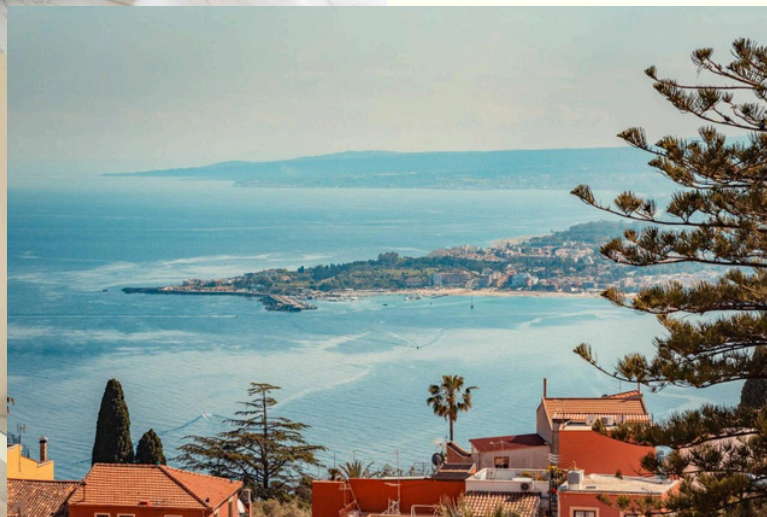

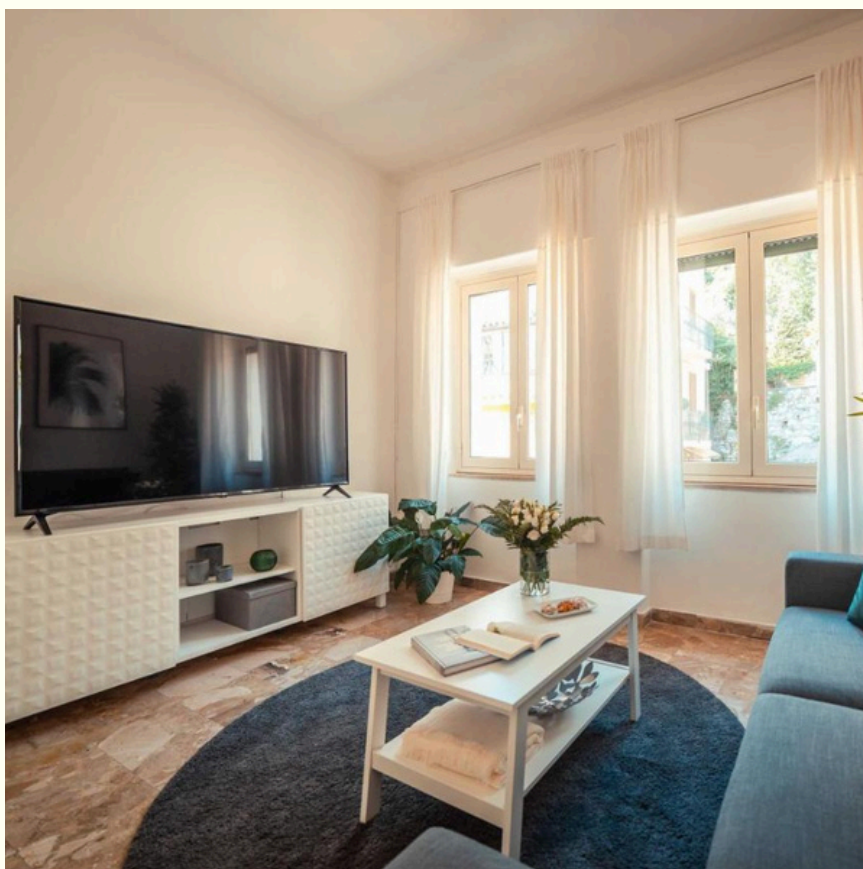


HOST FAMILY...

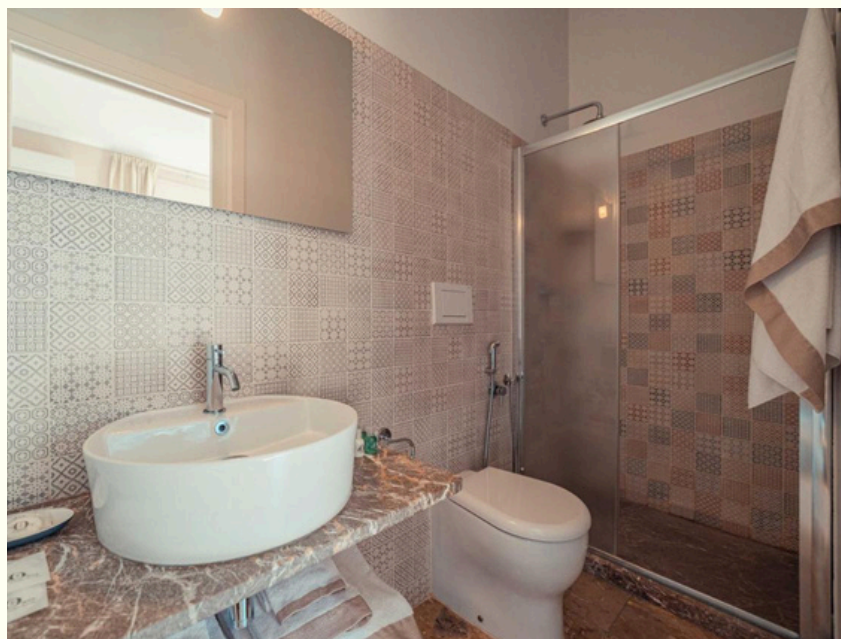

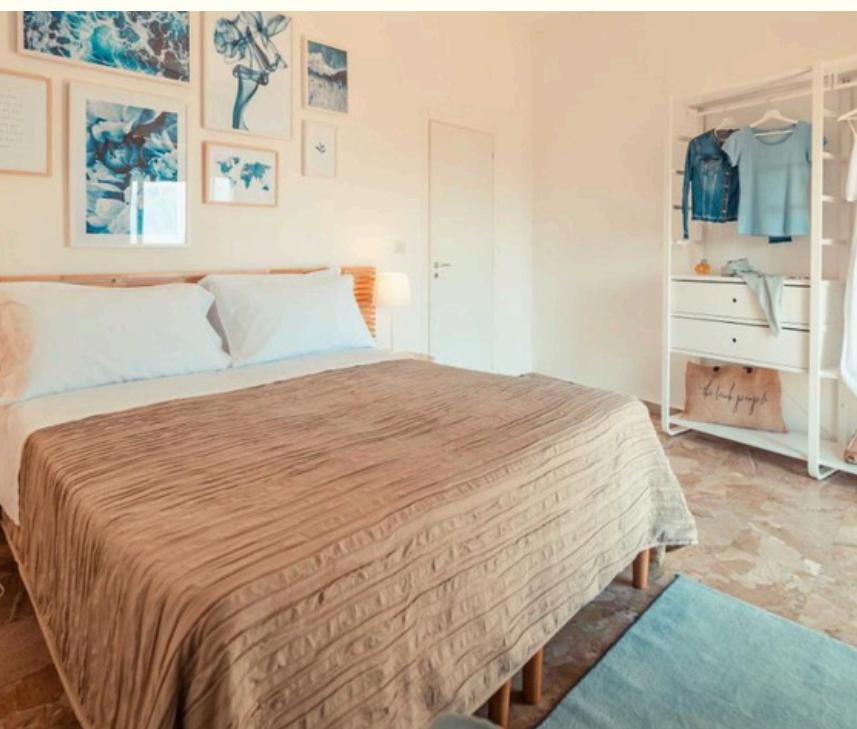

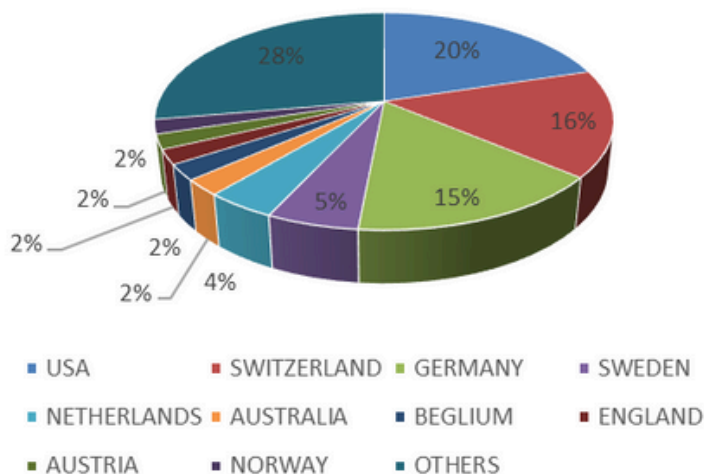

STUDENT STATISTICS BASED ON THE YEAR 2023 - N° STUDENTS: 2029



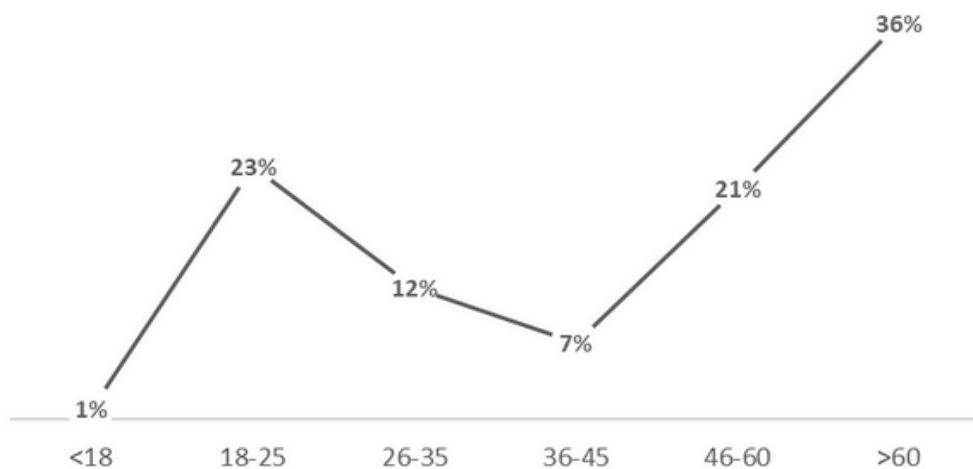

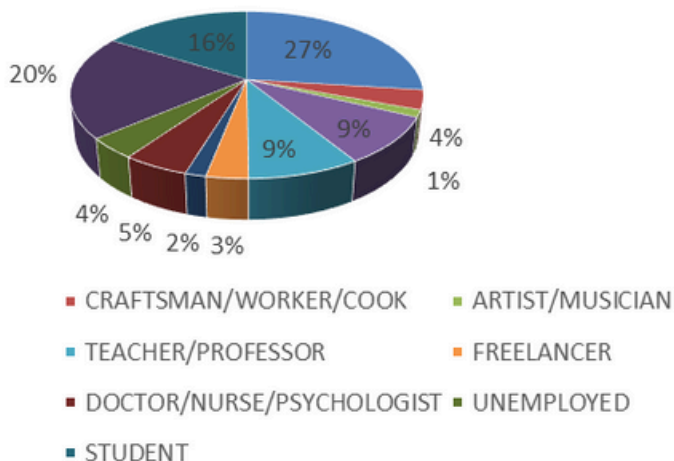
