Internship Placement Process

The placement process typically takes 8 weeks from the time we receive the application documents:

| Get in touch

Begin the process by reaching out to the Expanish team.

2. First call

Expanish team will respond to find out more about student's interest via video call.

3. Selection

Expanish staff selects an internship site based on conversation.

4. Interview

Students has video interview with internship supervisor.

5. Feedback

Expanish receives feedback to determine if it is a good fit.

6. Sign

Students have to sign a commitment letter.




Our school in Málaga is located in the historic center, over one floor of a traditional building just one block from the Cathedral of Málaga.


