The Irish Study & Work immigration Stamp 2 allows qualifying non-EU students the opportunity to study for a minimum of 15 hours per week, while legally working in Ireland for up to a maximum of 20 hours per week.

The Stamp 2 is valid for 8 months; 25 weeks, to study and 8 weeks of holidays. During designated holiday dates, students can work to a maximum of 40 hours per week.

Students have the option of renewing their Stamp 2 for a further two times as long as certain conditions are met, including a minimum of 85% attendance at school.

Most students choose ATC's accommodation for the first few weeks to allow them time to familiarise themselves with Bray or Dublin. See [page 22](#) for options.



Teacher Training & Erasmus+ Funded Mobilities

ATC welcomes educators and academic staff from across the globe to elevate their teaching and language skills with our 1 or 2 week practical training programmes.

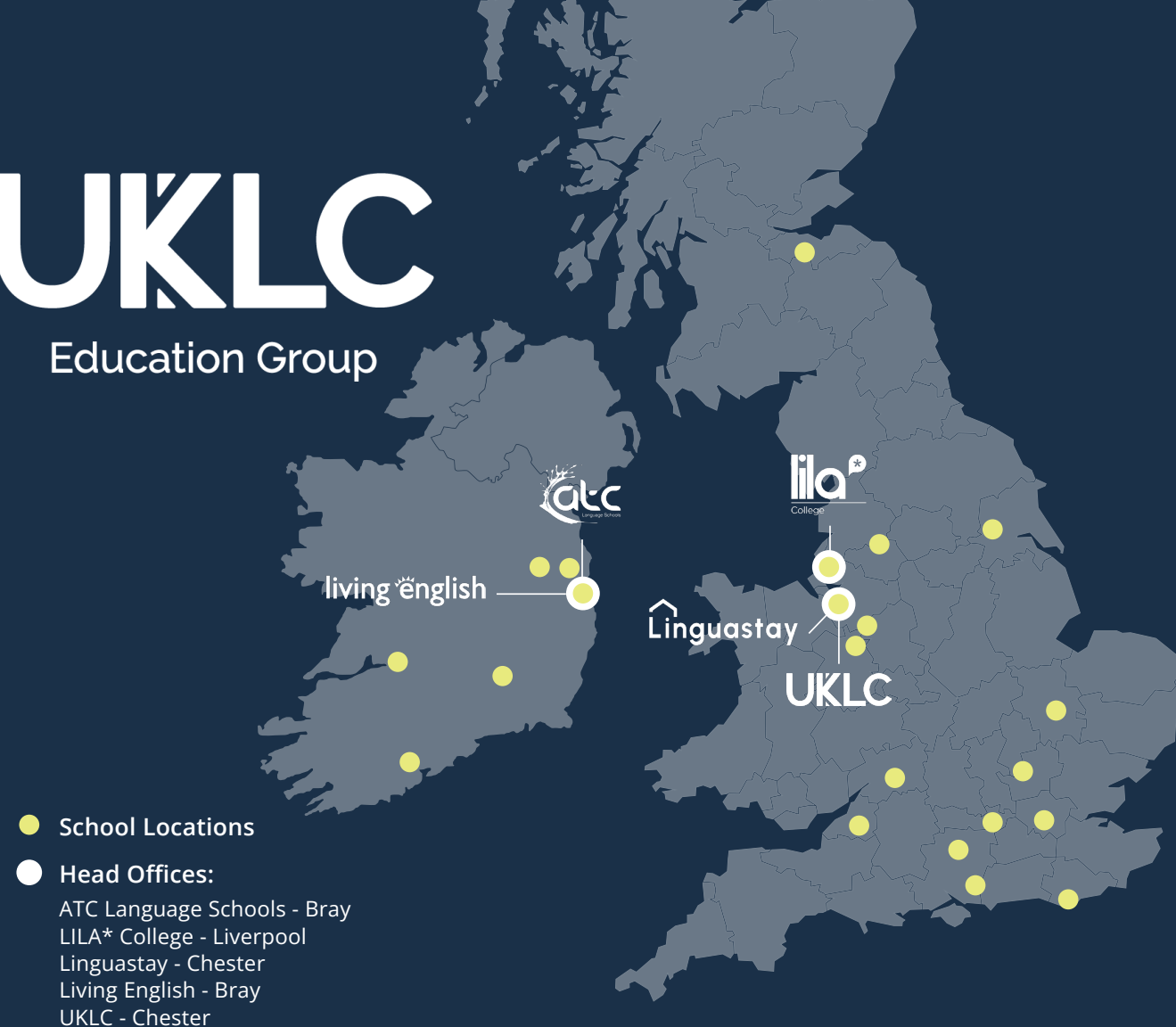

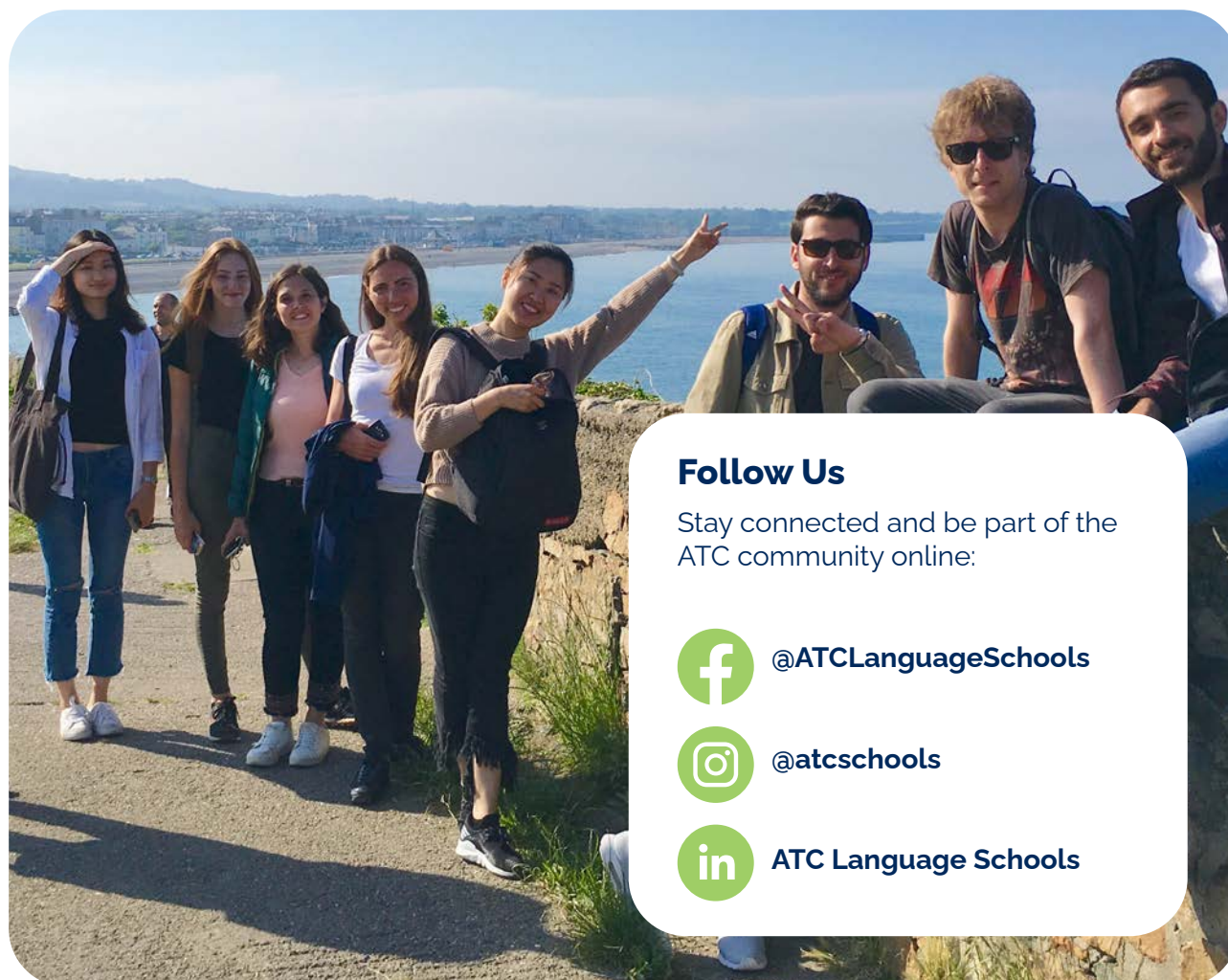
