

ERASMUS+ TEACHER TRAINING, CLIL & ENHANCED ENGLISH

We offer a range of courses that are eligible for funding through the Erasmus+ programme. All of our programmes are offered all year round and can be taken for either one or two weeks. You must apply through your school, university or company and can apply either individually or as a group with colleagues. Our PIC number for applications is **946680425**.

ERASMUS+ TEACHER TRAINING

This course is suitable for teachers of English at primary and secondary level. The course is designed to refresh existing skills and provide new ones through the Methodology component. Participants will have the chance to enhance their existing language skills during Spoken Performance classes and when participating in the various cultural and social activities on offer.

ERASMUS+ CLIL PROGRAMME

This course is designed for educators specialising in Content and Language Integrated Learning who wish to enhance and refresh their skills in delivering subject content in English. It is aimed at those who teach a subject such as science, history or geography using English as a foreign language. The programme also includes a Spoken Performance component to allow teachers to improve their fluency.

ENHANCED ENGLISH SKILLS




