Our Accommodation

HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION

Staying in a homestay accommodation is the best way to practice and improve your English and make new friends. You will be treated as a member of the household, eating together and sharing common living areas.

With around 200 homestays, this is the most popular option for many of our students and their group leaders.

Students will normally travel to and from their homestay accommodation using public transport (local buses), unless the house is within walking distance.

What is provided?

- A clean tidy room with a desk or table (or a room providing the same), adequate storage for clothes and a comfortable bed with a change of bed linen every 2 weeks
- Breakfast and dinner
- The host takes care of the student's light laundry once per week, or the student should have reasonable access to the washing machine
- Facility to have a shower every day with adequate hot water and towels available
- Sufficient light and heat

Placements & food

- Our homestay option provides accommodation with continental breakfast and an evening meal
- Weekday lunches are provided by the school
- Students are placed in shared rooms with students of different nationality
- Students from the same group can share on request
- Placement of students in accommodation is subject to change and availability
- We can not guarantee to meet specific requests for single/ shared rooms
- Single room/ private bathroom requests are subject to availability and an additional charge

Arrivals, First Day & Departure

- Homestays will collect students on arrival (unless student is going directly to their homestay via taxi)
- They will bring students to school on their first day and show them how to get to school
- They will collect them on their first day so students know how to get back home.
- They will collect them after School Disco on Fridays at 10pm
- They will drop off students on departure with their luggage and a packed lunch

All our homestay accommodation is organised by our own Accommodation Team. Homestays are regularly inspected by our team and have specific British Council criteria that they must satisfy.

Our Accommodation

RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION

YHA BATH HOSTEL



Situated in a beautiful Victorian mansion on Bathwick Hill, YHA is a short walk from our main school and conveniently located for our Summer School venue. A variety of shared and private rooms, including en-suite options, are available for groups accompanied by a group leader.

- Dormitory-style rooms of various sizes with shower and toilet facilities
- Juniors are split by gender
- Group leaders are placed in en-suite rooms close by
- Continental breakfast and evening meal available for groups of any size
- Weekday school lunches are provided by the school at Bath College, packed lunches provided by YMCA over the weekend
- Communal relaxation areas
- Staff with DBS checks
- Free WiFi

YMCA BATH HOSTEL



YMCA is situated in the centre of the city, it is directly opposite our main school and just a few minutes' walk from our Summer School venue. Both single and shared rooms are available to junior groups accompanied by a group leader.

- Double en-suite rooms for group leaders
- Twin, triple and quad rooms for juniors
- Lockable corridors for groups
- Continental breakfast and evening meal available for groups of 20 or more students
- Weekday school lunches are provided by the school at Bath College, packed lunches provided by YMCA over the weekend
- Single sex shared bathrooms
- Communal relaxation areas
- Staff with DBS checks
- Free WiFi



Residential and student accommodation is available for groups only on request at a supplement and must be booked well in advance due to popular demand

OTHER ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

EN-SUITE SELF-CATERING ACCOMMODATION

Just a 5-minute walk from Bath College and the city's main attractions, shops and restaurants, there is a student accommodation offering apartments for 4-7 people with en-suite rooms, a fully equipped kitchen and large communal dining space.

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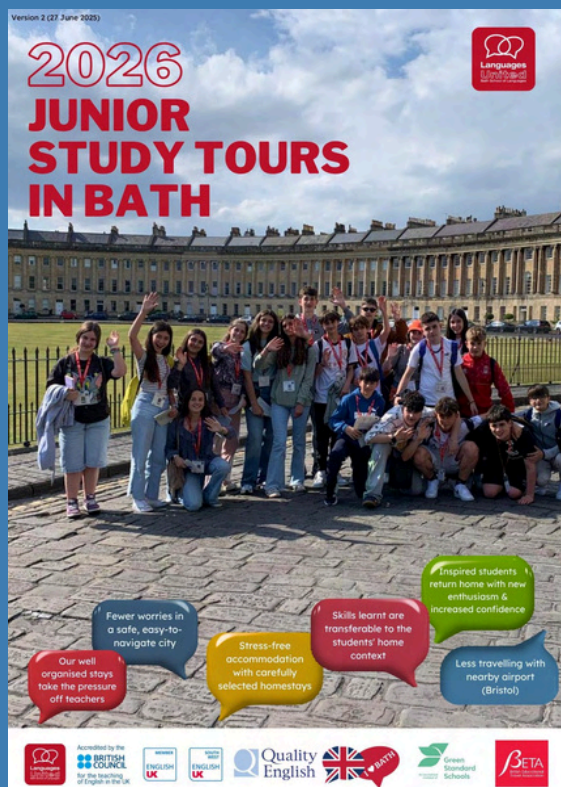
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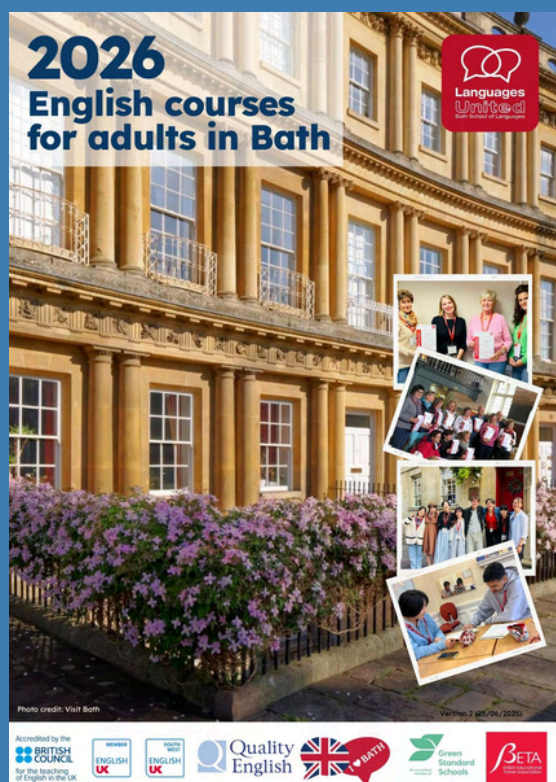
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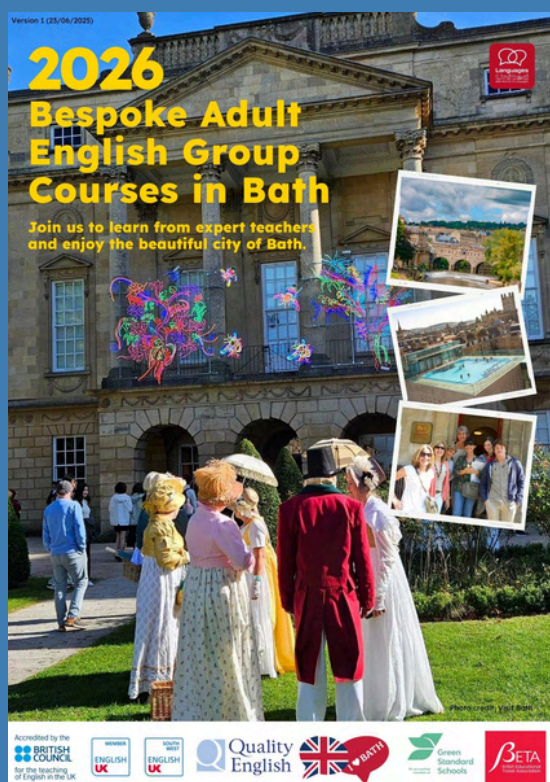
