TTP CLIL

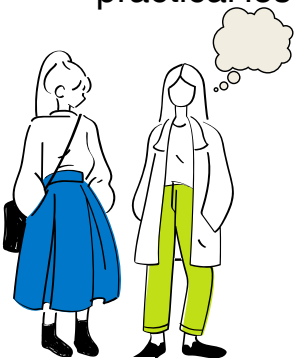

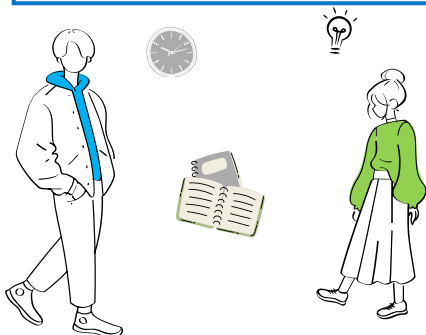
