## Course summary

In order to progress in any language, one thing you definitely need is vocabulary - and lots of it! Vocabulary really is at the heart of language, and the more of it you know, the more confident you will feel when using English. This course aims to improve your vocabulary in a number of different topics, and give a real boost to your communicative ability.

Part of this course will also focus on pronunciation. These sessions will give you a greater understanding of the different sounds of English, and raise your awareness of intonation and 'connected speech'.
