ACADEMIC – student, tourist or working holiday visas

GENERAL ENGLISH - FULL TIME

Classes focus on effective communication in English. Teachers use modern texts, internet, audio /DVD's, local newspapers and magazines to improve your reading, writing, speaking and listening skills.

Timetable: 9.00* – 10.30, 11.00 – 12.30, 13.30 – 15.00

22.5 hours per week formal classes with a teacher

* In October to March, some classes may start at 8.30am or 9.30am 1 - 4 weeks = \$430 per week, 5-12 weeks \$420 pw, 13 - 24 weeks = \$400 pw, 25 - 36 weeks = \$390 pw, 37 - 48 weeks = \$375 pw

Levels: elementary to advanced Students can start any Monday.

Preferred Start Dates: 7.1, 4.2, 4.3, 1.4, 29.4, 27.5, 24.6, 22.7, 19.8, 16.9, 14.10, 11.11, 9.12 (2 weeks). A new GE course block starts every 4 weeks.

GENERAL ENGLISH - PART TIME

Elementary to Advanced students attend 3 hours of class.

CAMBRIDGE FCE, CAE + CPE^ EXAM PREPARATION

Cambridge examinations provide successful students with an internationally recognised certificate of English language proficiency. Courses prepare students for FCE, CAE + CPE examinations. Focus is on speaking, reading, listening and writing and includes full practice tests under exam conditions. ^CPE course is afternoon private lessons – at cost - with CAE/ General English classes.

IELTS EXAM PREPARATION

The IELTS examination is an internationally recognised measure of English Language proficiency for university entry in English speaking countries (Academic module) and for general purposes (General Training module). The full-time course focuses on the four parts of the examination: Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking.

Level: intermediate – advanced. Max class size: 15 students

Timetable: 9.00* – 10.30, 11.00 – 12.30, 13.30– 15.00 22.5 hours

Duration: 12 weeks, min 8 weeks recommended. Students can join on other dates by request, subject to availability and level check.

Start Dates: 7.1, 1.4, 24.6, 16.9 - * =Tues as Mon.is holiday

* INDIVIDUAL TUITION

The school offers individual tuition if a student requires, to complement a General English course with English for Special Purpose e.g. IELTS, business, tourism, IT, art, etc. The school recommends a maximum of two hours per day face to face tuition.

ENGLISH PLUS LEARN TO SURF COURSE

Students study part-time General English and a 2 week learn to surf course for 4 afternoons (2.5 hours) per week. Our professional surfing school provides surfboard/body-board, wetsuit, rash vest, sunscreen and transport. It's great fun and very safe! Duration - 2 weeks.

ENGLISH PLUS DIVING

Full time General English plus SSI or PADI Open water dive courses over 2 consecutive weekends (Sat+Sun 8am–3pm). Minimum level required pre-intermediate. Duration - 2 full weeks \$1,345 - price is seasonal and medical examination fee is not included

ENGLISH PLUS YOGA

1 week = \$490

Full time General English plus 3 x 1.5 hours yoga lessons per week with Byron Yoga school (4pm – 5.30pm). Course starts every Monday

ENGLISH PLUS YOGA TEACHER TRAINING

Full time General English followed by accredited Yoga teacher training course. Courses are 20 day, 2 month or 12 months Certificate IV. Minimum level required to start yoga course - intermediate.

ENGLISH PLUS MUSIC

Students combine part time English plus 3 afternoons of private music lessons (50 minutes) per week. Duration - 1 - 8 weeks Prices do not include instrument hire. 1 week \$545

TEEN PROGRAM - ENGLISH PLUS ACTIVITIES

Students study part time English every morning and do afternoon activities each week. Students take part in activities to motivate the use of their English skills in our community as well as to experience some of the wonderful things our town has to offer. Duration: 2 – 4 weeks.

Start dates – any Monday in July + August only

Fees: 2 weeks \$1,100 4 weeks \$2,200 – tuition and activities only

FARMSTAY

Live and work on an organic WWOOF farm near Byron Bay. Free accommodation in exchange for 4-6 hours of work per day, available only after a student has completed a minimum two-week course. See wwoof.com.au for information. Placement fee = \$250.

COMBINATION PROGRAMS

Students may choose any combination of the courses listed above. E.g. 4 weeks = 2 wk GE Full Time + 2 wk English plus Surfing

HOSTEL offers shared dormitory accommodation and are self-catering. BBELS offers some dormitory style accommodation at the school for students who arrive early for homestay or student house. It is also available at the end of their course if they stay longer in Byron Bay, subject to availability.

PRIVATE ROOMS / APARTMENTS are available but are subject to seasonal variations. Private rooms are in shared houses with local people. Students have use of kitchen / laundry facilities.

GUARDIANSHIP - Students under 18 years of age only

Parents of students enrolling at BBELS must nominate a guardian living in Byron Bay who will be responsible for the welfare of the child whilst studying at BBELS or request the BBELS Guardianship Service.

HOW TO ENROL AT BBELS:

1. Read carefully our [Terms and Conditions of Enrolment](#) and our [Refund Policy](#).

2. Complete the [online registration form](#) We will then assist you with your enrolment processing.

3. Forward payment to our bank account. See payment detail below. Students studying on student visas must also purchase OSHC insurance for the duration of their course –see Insurance below.

4. When we receive your registration form and full payment, we will return a receipt and a Confirmation of Enrolment (COE). The COE is needed for immigration purposes only if you are applying for a Student Visa. Take it to the Australian Embassy with your visa application. Make sure you allow sufficient time for the processing of your visa.

5. Once you receive your visa, forward us your:

- flight /arrival details
- full payment

Full payment of fees is due before course commencement date.

6. If you have requested homestay and / or airport pick up, please advise us of your arrival details at least 2 weeks before your arrival in Australia.

7. We will provide you with your homestay details 2 weeks before your arrival, or as soon as all the above information has been provided.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Please see www.homeaffairs.gov.au or [email](#) us for visa advice. If you are studying 12 weeks or less, you require a Tourist Visa. If you are under 30 and your country has an agreement with Australia, you can apply for a Working Holiday Visa. If you choose to study full time for more than 12 weeks, you must apply for a Student Visa.
