How to book

To apply for a course, we require a completed application form (one per person or one per family). We can then process the booking and send you a confirmation letter and an invoice, including payment details.

Please note that we require a deposit of £160 per student on receipt of confirmation of the booking, and for the remaining fees to be paid no later than four weeks before the arrival date.

We are happy to issue a visa invitation letter (where required) once we have received the £160 deposit and the passport number.

We reserve the right to suspend services if payment has not been received.

Cancellations, postponement and course changes

Subject to availability, it will be possible to change the course whilst at the Globe, if we receive sufficient notice. You will be re-invoiced according to the length of the stay. Students upgrading to a different programme will be charged the difference between the two courses.

Globe Rules

1. If a student is worried at all they must immediately speak with their teacher or group leader. They will be glad to help.
2. If a student goes out they must always tell their teacher or host family where they are going and when they will return.
3. Discovery students walking to and from home, are not accompanied by Globe or their hosts.
4. Students must return to their homestays:
 By 18.30 if they are aged 13 years or under (After 18.00 late September to May)
 By 22.00 if they are aged 14 or 15 years (By 20.30 late September to May)
 By 23.00 if they are age 16 + (By 22.30 late September to May)
5. Students must use their own phone where possible and get permission to use the family phone. To help students settle in, we recommend parents wait 48h before calling and do not call more than twice a week.
