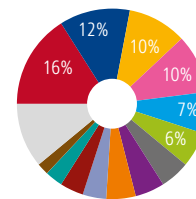
ST. PETERSBURG

The city of St. Petersburg was founded in 1703 by the visionary Tsar, Peter the Great, who aimed to build a capital to rival the great cities of Europe. While it may no longer be Russia's political capital, there is no doubt that St. Petersburg remains the country's cultural capital.

MOSCOW

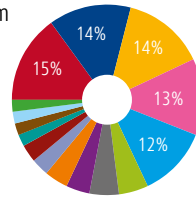

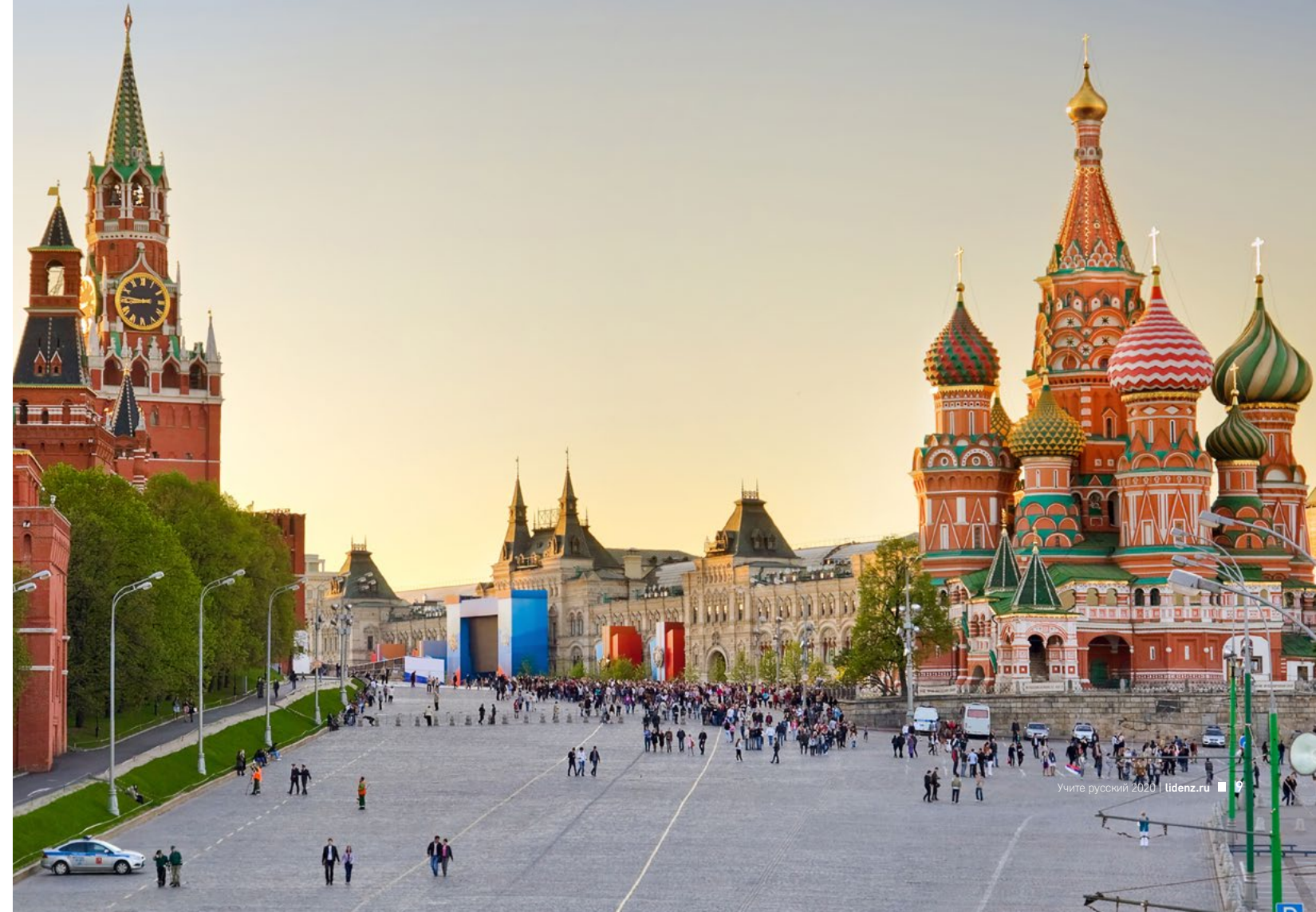

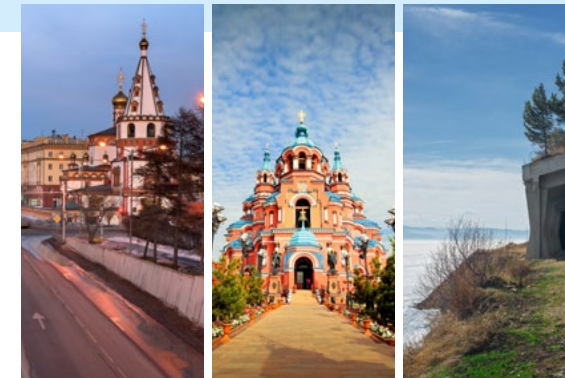

IRKUTSK

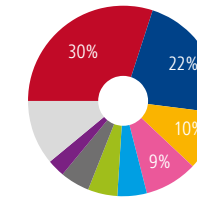
Liden & Denz in Irkutsk is located in the historical centre of the Eastern Siberian capital, in a recently renovated landmark building from the 19th century at the corner of Gryaznova ulitsa and ulitsa Karla Marksa.

Never mind the name (Karl Marx) but ulitsa Karla Marksa is undoubtedly the most beautiful street in Irkutsk with its own distinctive spirit. Its construction in the 19th century was inspired by Nevsky Prospekt in St.Petersburg. The Angara River and the monument of Alexander III are within walking distance, as well as, the popular pedestrian zone of the Fashion Block with its restaurants and cafés which now reside within the walls of some of the cities original and historically important wooden houses.

The Dekabristov museums (Trubetskoy and Volkonsky Mansions) are easily accessible by public transport, the nearest bus stop is directly in front of our campus.

RIGA

Riga, the historic capital of Latvia, is the largest city in the Baltic republics. The country gained independence from the Soviet Union in 1991, but the high population of ethnic Russians means that Riga has a clear majority of Russian speakers, making it an excellent centre for studying the Russian language. Latvia joined the European Union in 2004 and since then Riga has become a vibrant hub for businesses operating between Russia and the EU.

Riga has some of the finest Art Nouveau architecture anywhere in Europe, but its history goes back much further. The Vecriga, the medieval heart of the city, is home to the Town Hall Square with the iconic House of the Blackheads. On the outskirts of the city lies Jurmala, a wonderful beach resort with beautiful parkland — a great place to escape the busy city centre.

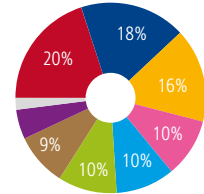

- Courtyard area for relaxing and Summer barbecues!

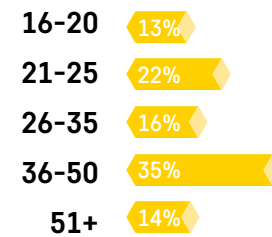


Student Mix by Country or Region

THE SECRET OF OUR SUCCESS

At all Liden & Denz Institutes, our primary focus is to develop as quickly and accurately as possible our student's communication, reading and comprehension skills in the Russian language. The investments we make in our schools, the assessment and development of new course materials and, most importantly, the continual training and support of our staff are always aimed at improving our award-winning courses and getting positive outcomes for our students.

We focus on mastering the Russian language in various communication situations, starting from colloquial interaction up to more proficient levels. We also offer training in reading Russian texts and newspapers.

Our teachers

with substantial levels of noise, likely to distract them.

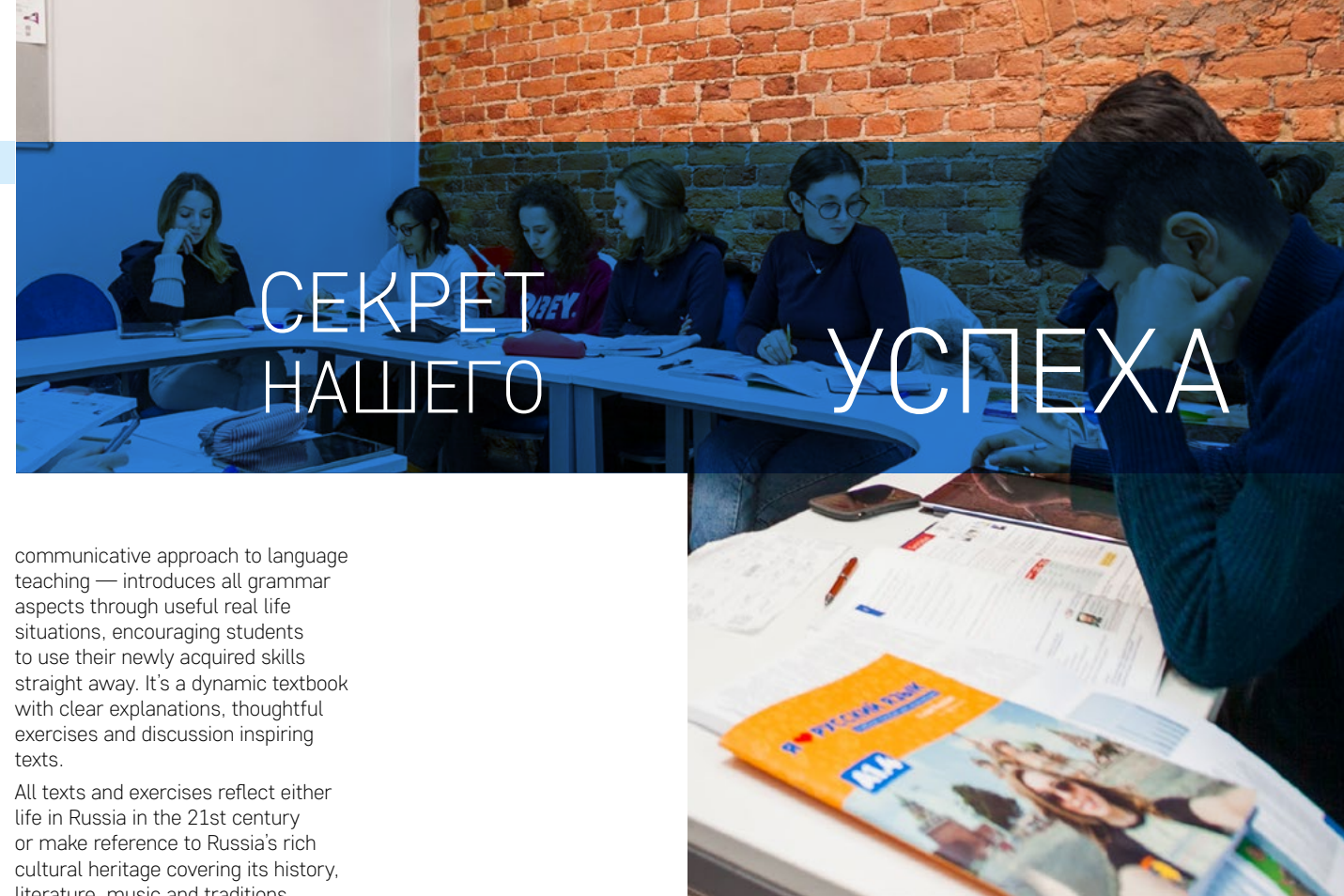

RUSSIAN COURSE BOOK

«Я люблю русский язык»

I love Russian is a new, illustrated course book series aimed at international students studying Russian. Currently available are: **“I love Russian” A1 (beginner), A2 (elementary – pre-intermediate), B1.1 (intermediate) and B1.2 (upper-intermediate)**. All books come with rich audio material, accessible by smartphone or web browser. The books are entirely written in Russian and primarily designed to be used in the classroom for both group and individual students.

I love Russian has a clear structure and — in accordance with the



communicative approach to language teaching — introduces all grammar aspects through useful real life situations, encouraging students to use their newly acquired skills straight away. It's a dynamic textbook with clear explanations, thoughtful exercises and discussion inspiring texts.

All texts and exercises reflect either life in Russia in the 21st century or make reference to Russia's rich cultural heritage covering its history, literature, music and traditions.

I love Russian has been written by an academic team of Russian language teachers working at Liden & Denz. The course books have been tried and extensively tested at our campuses in St.Petersburg, Moscow, Riga and Irkutsk.

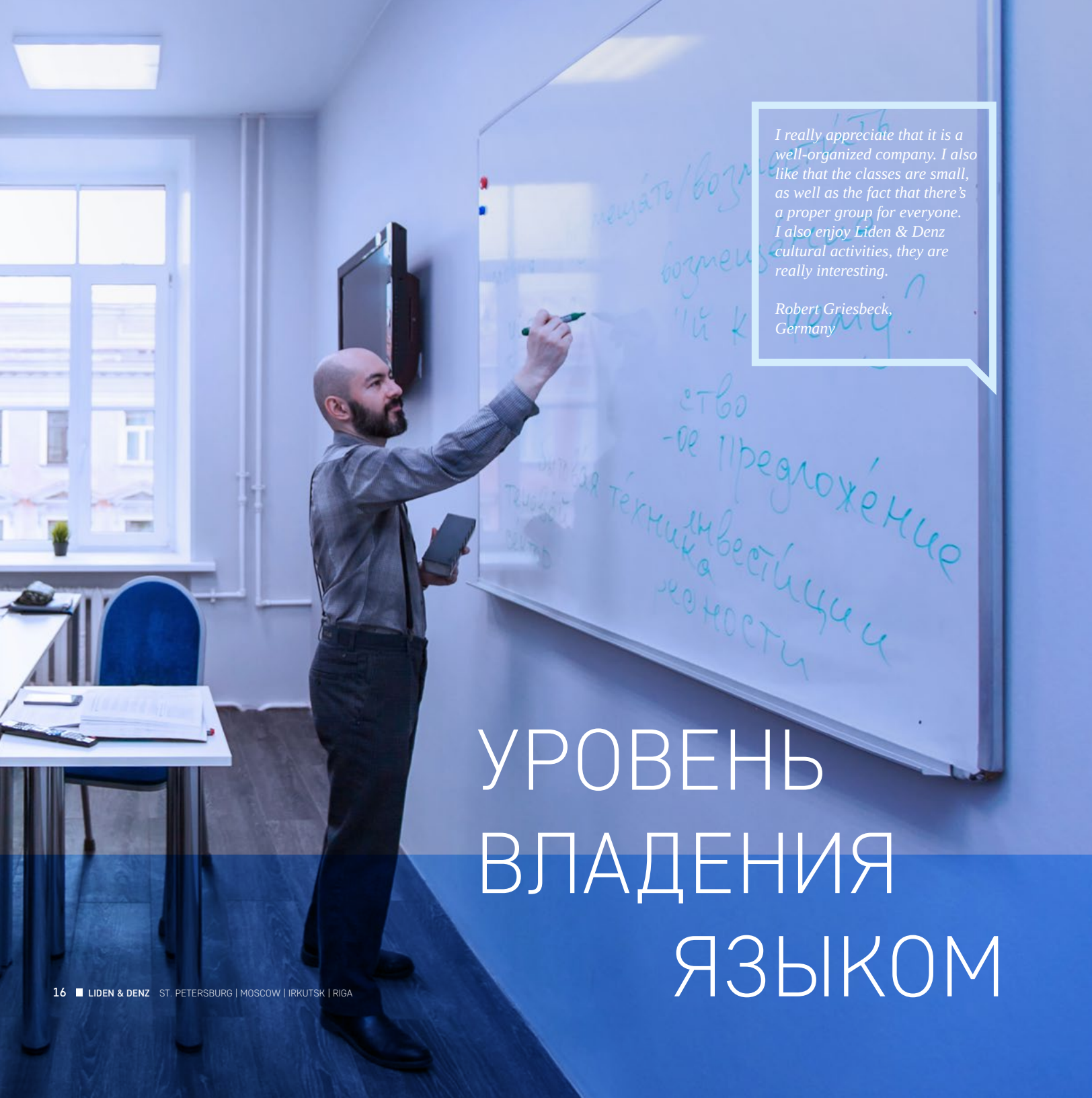
At Liden & Denz Language Institutes you will:

COURSE LEVELS

Our course levels are adapted from the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). In our Group Course, we teach 8 levels of Russian year-round (beginner to advanced). Lessons last 50 minutes and the numbers shown below are averages, based on our experience of past students. Students enrolling for a One-to-One Course will need fewer lessons to pass from one level to the next.

GROUP COURSES

Our teaching method, in small multinational groups, uses no intermediary language: we teach Russian in Russian from day one. This develops an ability to interact in Russian much faster and helps overcome any language barrier. Our communicative approach to teaching makes the educational process an enjoyable and efficient experience. You will quickly learn grammar, using new words and language skills adapted to daily situations.



Standard Group Course

This course of 20 lessons per week is available all year round, with a weekly intake of new students following a modular pattern of two-week units. Group courses operate from Monday to Friday with a minimum course length of one week and no maximum.

The curriculum is built up like a spiral, where each new level of language acquisition starts with the revision of previously studied grammar constructions, logically connected with different speech patterns. This has two advantages: group newcomers are able to feel involved in the learning process, while continuing students acquire new vocabulary based on previously acquired grammar material.

Groups are formed according to an assessment test, which is compulsory for all students. A very important minimum requirement for all group courses is passive knowledge of the Cyrillic alphabet.

Intensive Group Course

If you choose our Intensive Group Course, you will have 20 morning lessons with students following the Standard Group Course and 5 additional lessons, taught on two afternoons. Intensive Group Courses are offered all year in three different levels:

- Elementary (A1/A1+)
- Pre-intermediate (A2/A2+)
- Intermediate (B1/B1+)

Intensive Group Courses are also available at **Upper Intermediate (B2/B2+)** and **Advanced (C1)** levels when there is sufficient demand.

Casual Russian Course

St.Petersburg and Moscow are cities that never sleep and with lots of things to do after classes. Especially for those who want to have enough time to discover the treasures of St. Petersburg or Moscow, we have designed a group course with less lessons than our standard group courses and timings which allow for enough sleep after a long night out. This course of 15 lessons per week is available from mid-September until mid-May with weekly intakes and usually starts at 15:00, Monday to Friday. The minimum course length is one week. Levels offered: A0-B1+. This course is available only in St.Petersburg and Moscow.

Teacher Refreshment Course

This 10 lessons per week one-to-one course module equips teachers of Russian as a Foreign Language with methods and teaching techniques following our communicative approach. This course is a professional development tool concentrating on methodology.

The outcome of the course is a new perspective of the aims and objectives of teaching Russian in a modern world; focussing on a widened scope of methods, practical skills and insights on teaching specific topics (especially grammar). Russian language teachers taking this course are invited to observe and analyse the lessons of experienced Liden & Denz teachers teaching classes of different levels to gain classroom management confidence.

The Teacher Refreshment Course can be booked in addition to a Standard Group Course at a high level, or as a stand-alone individual course.

SPECIALIST COURSES

Academy: Language + Russian history and cultural studies

The Academy is a joint programme in collaboration with a prestigious private university in St.Petersburg, blending 20 weekly group language lessons at Liden & Denz with a well-organised and thorough study of Russia's history, focusing on the topics that had had an important impact on geopolitics, art, science, religion, and social developments. Our university partner lies within a walking distance from the Liden & Denz campus. These studies in Russian history and culture form a solid ground for further research in the fields of politics, sociology, economics, history, art or linguistics, both fundamental and applied. The minimum stay for the Academy Course is 20 weeks and students can proceed to the Russian history and cultural studies (2 lessons weekly) only after they have reached an A2 level of Russian.

One-to-One Courses

Our One-to-One Courses are designed for students who require a very focussed area of study. You will be invited to specify your field of interest when completing the online booking form, so that we can pre-select material, establish a study plan and prepare specific vocabulary.

One-to-one courses are available in varying degrees of intensity: 15, 20, 30 or 40 lessons per week. For 30 lessons or more the student is taught by two teachers.

Individual courses can be booked throughout the year. The minimum course length is one week with each course starting on a Monday and ending on a Friday, though weekend classes can be organised on request. Participants may also book an additional 5 lessons as a supplement to any One-to-One or Group Course.

Exam Preparation Course (TRKI)

TRKI is the state test of Russian as a foreign language. It offers an adult-oriented syllabus, is available at 6 levels, and tests all the skills required to use Russian language properly.

A TRKI Preparation Course is a combination of a Group Course (Standard or Intensive) or a One-to-one Course and a TRKI Preparation Module. The TRKI Preparation Module is a supplement taken just before the TRKI exam. Each module comprises 5 individual lessons. The number of modules required in order to pass a certain exam is jointly determined by the student and the teacher.

Since August 2019 you can sit the TRKI exam in our St.Petersburg campus. We also offer free counselling and mock testing to better understand which level you should take.

СПЕЦИАЛЬНЫЕ КУРСЫ



Combination Courses

These courses combine our standard Group or One-to-One courses with additional, more focussed study in a variety of business or cultural fields.

■ Russian for Special Purposes (RSP)

These attractively-priced, professional courses are tailor-made for staff working in the following fields:

- Hotel and tourism (hospitality)
- Airline staff (flight attendants)
- Alpine ski instructors.

Students will join a standard group course (20 lessons per week) but receive an additional 5 One-to-One lessons per week tailored to their particular profession.

■ Business Russian

This module of 5 afternoon lessons in mini-groups of up to 4 students can be taken year-round but can only be booked in addition to a full-time Group or One-to-one course programme.

Minimum level to enrol – A2.

This module gives useful language for everyday business situations: telephone calls, making appointments, running a meeting, dealing with clients. On higher levels it develops practical language skills within real business scenarios: presentations, negotiations, meetings and discussions.

Internships

Liden & Denz is one of the first organisations to offer meaningful study and work programmes in Moscow and St. Petersburg. Although our staff supervise the students on their assignments, the experience with the host organisation is very authentic.

For legal reasons, all internships are unpaid and students should be aware that they will also need to cover accommodation and insurances costs.

To qualify for an internship, you will need to have at least an A2 level of Russian on arrival. You will also need to study for a minimum of four weeks in a standard Group Course or three weeks One-to-One in one of our institutes, prior to the start of the work assignment. The minimum age for internships is 18, however some organisations set a higher minimum. Internships can last from two weeks to three months, depending on the requirements of our host organisations.



ONLINE COURSES

Our live, online courses have the same teachers and lesson content as the residential classes in our institutes. Lessons are conducted in exactly the same way, ensuring you benefit from our award winning teaching methods. While these lessons are ideal for students who cannot attend our schools in person, they can also be used as preparation before a course at one of our institutes or for further study following a stay.

All you require is a computer with a microphone, a camera and an internet connection to see, hear and speak with your teacher, as if they were in the room with you. As well as conversing with your teachers in Russian, you will write and type grammar lessons, all from the comfort of your home or workplace.

There are three main reasons why online lessons may be the right option for you:

■ Remote study

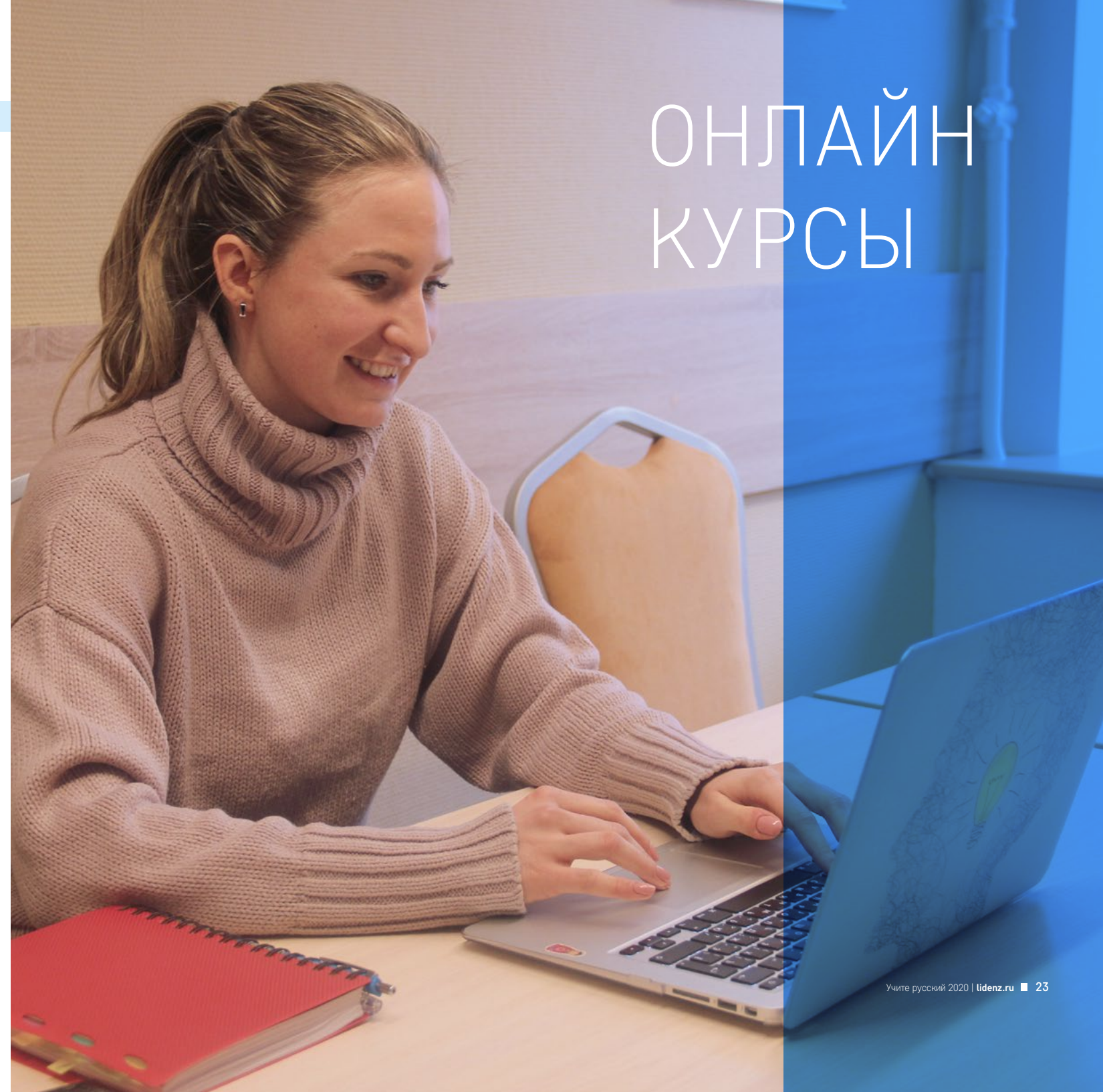

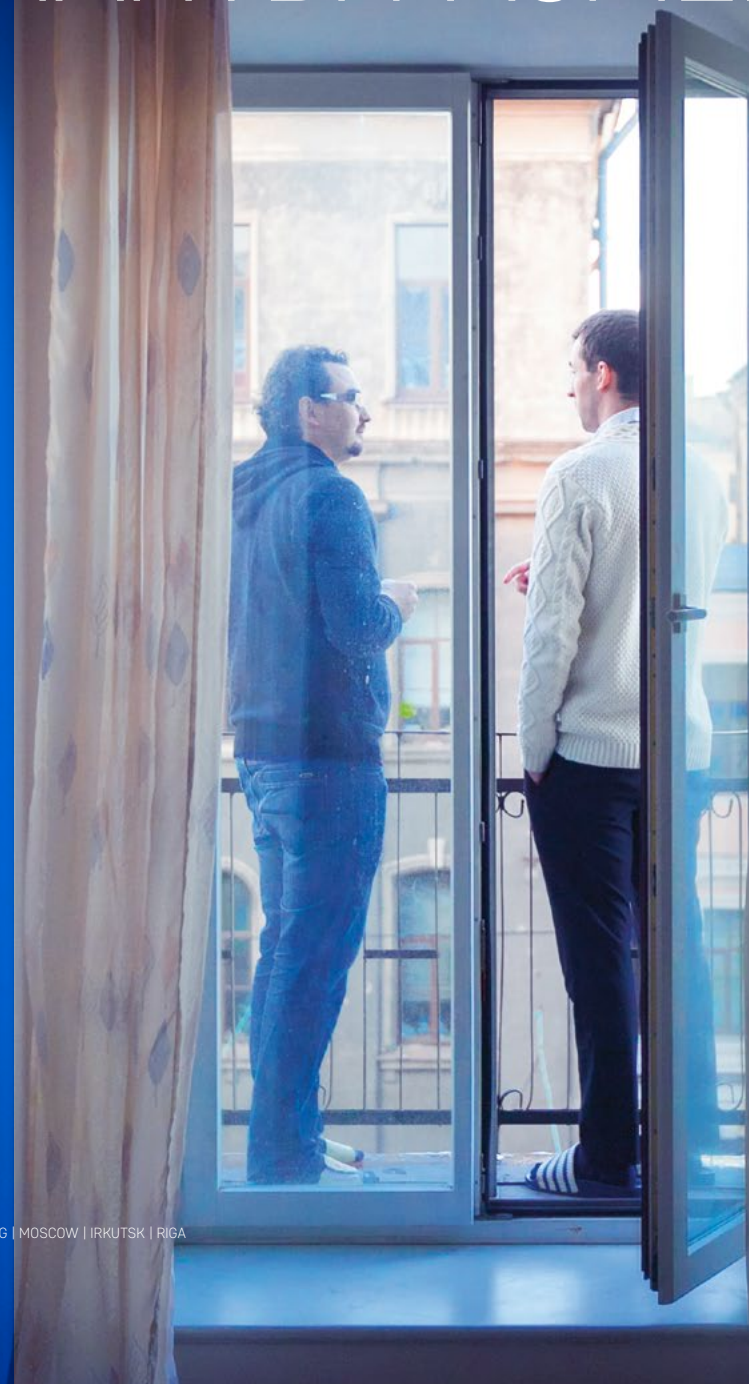

■ Homestay

Homestay, as the name suggests, is when you stay with a Russian-speaking family, in their home. Often this will be with a traditional family with children, however, we also have couples and single hosts.

The benefit of Homestay is that you can practice your new found language skills, while experiencing everyday Russian or Latvian life. Hosts are chosen because they are very sociable, so will take time to talk to you, as well as being patient, understanding and caring. They are also there to help with any problem that may arise during your Russian language stay.

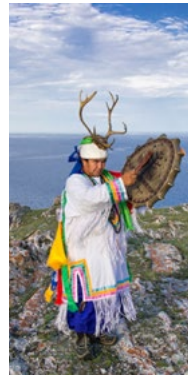

St. Petersburg
